



Road rules in Switzerland for foreign guests of International WIMA Rally

We drive on the right side of the road.

- In town 50 km/h Out of town 80 km/h and On motorway 120 km/h
- In case of an accident or breakdown, put on your signal vest immediately
- Alcohol is 0.0 per thousand of alcohol for young drivers (up to 25 years of age). From 26 years of age: 0.5 per thousand.
- In Switzerland, a motorway vignette is mandatory The vignette costs 40 francs and is valid until the end of January 2023 it can be bought at petrol stations and border crossings
- In Switzerland, it is not allowed to overtake in traffic jams or standing traffic.
- You may only park the motorcycle in the parking spaces specially designated for motorcycles or in the parking spaces for cars.
- For parking in a “paid parking” space for cars, you have to pay.
- At traffic lights. Don't drive in front
- In the event of a breakdown on the motorway, always use the emergency lane and put on your signal vest.
- Always drive with lights on
- A helmet is mandatory. protective clothing is recommended
